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Speakers' Bio Briefs

Mr. Leong Sze Hian

A veteran advocate, Mr. Leong brings much academic and professional rigour to the analysis of Singapore's fiscal landscape. An alumnus of Harvard University, Mr Leong has three Masters degrees and 13 professional qualifications. He has served as President of four professional and human rights organizations. He has an extensive media footprint— over 1,500 citations and a career as a radio host and columnist— and has been a speaker as a Wharton Fellow in over 40 countries. Mr. Leong offers a critical and comprehensive breakdown of the Singapore Budget 2026

Ms. Wendy Low Wei Ling

A distinguished intellectual property lawyer and a partner at Eldan Law LLP, Ms Low is recognized as one of the "50 IP Litigators You Should Know" in the Asia Pacific. Her legal expertise in digital rights and e-commerce is matched by a profound commitment to social advocacy. She has worked closely with NGOs like AWARE to support women and migrant workers. It has also led her to contest multiple General Elections. She is currently the Head of the Women's Wing in the Progress Singapore Party. From her roots in Tiong Bahru to her international presence at the WIPO General Assembly, Wendy bridges the gap between high-level policy and grassroots reality, whilst also leveraging from her background in tech-law and community volunteerism to champion sustainable employment and the growth of local SMEs.

Dr. Jeremy Lim

A leading voice in healthcare transformation, Dr Lim is the CEO and Co-Founder of AMILI, Southeast Asia's first microbiome insights company. With a background in surgery and public health from the UK and US, his career spans senior roles in both public and private sectors, including advisory positions with the World Bank and the World Health Organization. As an adjunct faculty member at NUS and a board member for various health-focused non-profits, Dr. Lim operates at the intersection of medical innovation and policy. He brings specialized insight into health financing, digital health interventions, and community care models, ensuring a robust discussion on the future of Singapore's health ecosystem.

Mr. Tay Kheng Soon

A pioneering architect and urban thinker, Mr Tay has been an influence on Singapore's built environment for over six decades. A former President of the Singapore Institute of Architects and a Fellow of the World Academy of Art and Science, he is the visionary behind the "Tropical City Concept" and on the preservation of the Golden Mile Complex. Beyond his architectural accolades, Mr. Tay is a dedicated public educator and founder of the Future of Singapore Group (FOSG), where his work on the "HDB Dilemma" has directly been an influence in parliamentary debates. As the author of the 2025 book *Future of Singapore?*, he offers a provocative and human-centric perspective on how land use and housing must evolve to foster social harmony and environmental sustainability.
