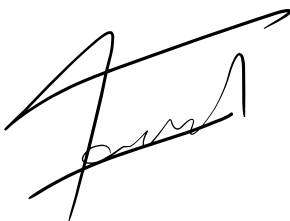
Dear Prime Minister

I am writing to inform you of my decision to resign as a Political Office Holder, Member of Parliament, and a member of the People's Action Party with immediate effect, for personal reasons.

A situation has arisen involving my conduct with a female member of the public. While there was no physical relationship between us, and I did not intend for the interactions to develop into one, there was a lapse of judgment on my part in the way I handled the interactions, and in failing to establish clearer boundaries at an earlier stage.

On reflection, I recognise that my conduct fell short of the standards expected of me and was not consistent with the responsibilities entrusted to me. I have therefore decided it is right for me to step away from politics, so that I can devote my time and attention to my family.

I thank PM and the Party for your support and friendship over the years.
