Dear Prime Minister,

We refer to your letter dated 15 January 2026, delivered through our Secretary-General Pritam Singh.

We are unable to accept your invitation to nominate another Workers' Party Member of Parliament to the Leader of the Opposition (LO) post, as the Workers' Party has our own established processes for electing our leadership.

In Singapore, the position of LO is a discretionary appointment that the Prime Minister makes. Despite not having any constitutional or statutory eligibility criteria, we hold the view that the only tenable candidate for the LO position would be a Member of Parliament who is the leader of the largest opposition party in Parliament, the Workers' Party.
